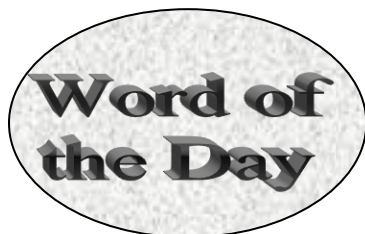

SENIORS - The school board approved the declaration of senior Chromebooks as surplus for \$10 **IF** they choose to purchase one. If they do not choose to purchase one, their Chromebooks are being retained by the technology department. Any senior interested, provide an email to Mrs. Radtke, Mrs. Alva and Technology that they are interested in purchasing their Chromebooks for \$10. **They MUST pay the \$10 before May 22, otherwise, this offer is no longer good.** If they fail to turn it in without paying, they are liable for the entire cost which may be closer to \$300. So, it is extremely important that you take responsibility in communicating with the three mentioned above. This does mean that you are to turn in your Chromebook and then you will receive it back.

All Student Drivers: ALL student drivers are **REQUIRED** to have a current driving tag on your vehicle be able to drive to school. Last year's tag is not valid. If you do not have a 2023-2024 tag, please stop in the high school office for the form you need to fill out and return. There will be a \$10.00 charge for the tag. You will also need to turn in a copy of the Consent Form for the Drug Testing and Education Program. We will need to make a copy of your driver's license. If you get your driver's license later in the year and want to drive to school, you will also need a driving tag.
