In addition to tending to our physical health, Pulaski County also has local programs available for mental health. Here are some options below:



Four County Counseling offers a number of health services, including: Child and Adolescent Services, Medication Clinic, Supported Employment, Residential Services, Psychiatric Services, Adult Services, School-based Services,

Addition/Recovery Services, Wrap-Around Programs, Outpatient Services, and Psychology services.

Many of these services take place in the Winamac office. But some services can travel to the individual, especially in cases where children are involved. Wraparound and school-based case management is available on-site at Eastern Pulaski and West Central Schools.
